GENERAL INFORMATION

The information provided below gives a simple overview of what happens to your personal data when you visit our website. Personal data is any data with which you can be personally identified. Detailed information on the subject of data privacy can be found in our data privacy policy listed under this text.

DATA COLLECTION ON OUR WEBSITE

Who is responsible for data collection on this website?

Data processing on this website is carried out by the website operator. Their contact data can be found in the Legal Notice of this website.

How do we collect your data?

Your data is collected when you communicate it to us. This may involve data that you enter in a contact form, for example. Other data is automatically collected by our IT systems when you visit the website. This is mainly technical data (e.g. Internet browser, operating system, time of page access). This data is collected automatically as soon as you enter our website.

For what purpose do we use your data?

Some of the data is collected to ensure that the website runs error-free. Other data may be used to analyze your user behavior.

What are your rights concerning your data?

You have the right at any time to free information concerning the origin, recipients, and purpose of your stored personal data. In addition, you have the right to request rectification, restriction, or erasure of this data. You can contact us at any time concerning this and other questions related to data privacy via the address stated in the Legal Notice. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.

ANALYSIS TOOLS AND THIRD-PARTY TOOLS

When you visit our website, your surfing behavior can be statistically evaluated. This is done primarily with cookies and so-called analysis programs. The analysis of your surfing behavior is usually anonymous; the surfing behavior cannot be traced back to you. You can object to this analysis, or prevent it by not using certain tools. You will find detailed information on this in the following data privacy policy. You can object to this analysis. We will inform you about the possibilities of objection in this data privacy policy.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND MANDATORY INFORMATION ON DATA PRIVACY

The operators of these pages take the protection of your personal data very seriously. We treat your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the statutory data privacy regulations and this data privacy policy.

When you use this website, various personal data is collected. Personal data is any data with which you can be personally identified. This data privacy policy explains what data we collect, and what we use it for. It also explains how, and for what purpose, this is done.

We draw attention to the fact that data transfer in the Internet (e.g. when communicating by e-mail) can involve security loopholes. Absolute protection of data against access by third parties is not possible.

REVOCAION OF YOUR CONSENT TO DATA PROCESSING

Many data processing operations are only possible with your express consent. You can revoke your consent at any time. For this purpose, an informal e-mail to us is sufficient. The legality of the data processing carried out until the revocation remains unaffected by the revocation.

THE RIGHT TO LODGE A COMPLAINT WITH THE COMPETENT SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY

In the event of breaches of data protection law, the data subject shall have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority. The competent supervisory authority for data privacy issues is the data privacy officer of the German federal state in which our company is based.

THE RIGHT TO DATA PORTABILITY

You have the right to have data which we process automatically on the basis of your consent, or in fulfilment of a contract, handed over to you or to a third party in a common, machine-readable format. If you request the direct transfer of the data to another Controller, this will only be done if it is technically feasible.

SSL OR TLS ENCRYPTION

This website uses SSL or TLS encryption for security reasons and to protect the transmission of confidential content, such as orders or requests that you send to us as the site operator.

You can recognize an encrypted connection by the address line of the browser changing from “http://” to “https://” and by the padlock symbol in your browser bar.

If SSL or TLS encryption is activated, the data you transmit to us cannot be read by third parties.

INFORMATION, RESTRICTION, ERASURE

Within the framework of the applicable legal provisions, you have the right at any time to free information concerning your stored personal data, its origin and recipients, and the purpose of the data processing, as well as a right to correction, restriction, or erasure of this data. You can contact us at any time concerning this and other questions related to personal data via the address stated in the Legal Notice.

OBJECTION TO PROMOTIONAL E-MAILS

Use of contact data, published in the context of the mandatory legal notice, for the sending of advertising and information material not expressly requested, is hereby objected to. The operators of these pages expressly reserve the right to take legal steps in the event of the unsolicited sending of advertising information, for example via spam e-mails.

DATA COLLECTION ON OUR WEBSITE

COOKIES

The Internet sites in part use so-called cookies. Cookies do not damage your computer and do not contain viruses. Cookies are used to make our offer more user-friendly, more effective, and more secure. Cookies are small text files that are deposited on your computer and stored by your browser. Most of the cookies used by us are so-called "session cookies". They are automatically deleted at the end of your visit. Other cookies remain stored on your end device until you delete them. These cookies enable us to recognize your browser the next time you visit us.

You can adjust your browser such that you are informed of the setting of cookies and only allow cookies on a case-by-case basis, exclude the acceptance of cookies in specific circumstances or generally, and also activate the automatic deletion of cookies when the browser is closed.

Deactivating cookies can restrict the functionality of this website.

Cookies which are necessary for the execution of the electronic communication process or for the provision of certain functions desired by you (e.g. shopping basket function), are stored on the basis of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Point f of the GDPR. The website operator has a legitimate interest in the storage of cookies for the technically error-free and optimized provision of their services. Should other cookies (e.g. cookies for analyzing your surfing behavior) be stored, these are treated separately in this data privacy policy.

SERVER LOG FILES

The provider of the pages automatically collects and stores information in so-called server log files, which your browser automatically transmits to us. This information consists of:

- Browser type and browser version
- Operating system used
- Referrer URL
- Host name of accessing computer
- Time of server request
- IP address

This data is not merged with other data sources. The legal basis for data processing is Article 6, Paragraph 1, Point b of the GDPR, which permits data processing for the performance of a contract or in order to take steps prior to entering into a contract.

PLUGINS AND TOOLS

GOOGLE WEB FONTS

To ensure the uniform display of fonts, this page uses so-called web fonts provided by Google.

When you call up a page, your browser loads the required web fonts into its browser cache in order to display texts and fonts correctly.
